QUEBEC CITY HISTORICAL OVERVIEW (slide presentation) (DURATION: 1:30 HOURS)

It all started in 1534 ... or maybe way before that? We invite you to learn about Quebec before discovering it, street by street. Enjoy our conference offered by one of Quebec's most experienced historian followed by a short orientation tour.

AMERINDIAN TRADITION TOUR (DURATION: 3 HOURS)

They were here way before us and left us with a great history to discover! Visit the traditional Huron site "ONHOUA CHETEK8E" and you will discover the beliefs, customs, and way of life of our people, from times past to the present. "Koey Koey Ataro" (Hello my friend!). Huron guides call out upon your arrival. It is their way of welcoming you to their territory. Along the way, the guides will pass along some of their most precious secrets, helping you to come to know the Huron Nation and its rich and glorious past.

DISCOVER QUEBEC, A HISTORICAL CITY (DURATION: 3 HOURS)

A must-do tour! For 400 years, the sun has risen and set over the cradle of French civilization in North America: Quebec City. Experience the European charm of Quebec City, visit the Upper and Lower Town districts, and discover the Latin Quarter, the Ramparts, the main churches. Quebec City is a taste of Europe right here in North America.

WHALE WATCHING EXCURSION IN CHARLEVOIX (DURATION: 9 HOURS)

It's in the Charlevoix region that we find the most varieties of whales. Departing from Baie Ste-Catherine, situated approximately 300 km north-east of Québec City, we are proposing a three-hour discovery excursion allowing you to explore this important whale's refuge. All ships used for this adventure are government inspected and approved by the Canadian Coast Guard. Warm clothing is recommended since cool temperatures can be expected on the river.

Includes: *Motorcoach transportation to the Charlevoix region with our professional guide; 3 hours whale watching cruise, lunch included, Octopus DMC coordination.*
